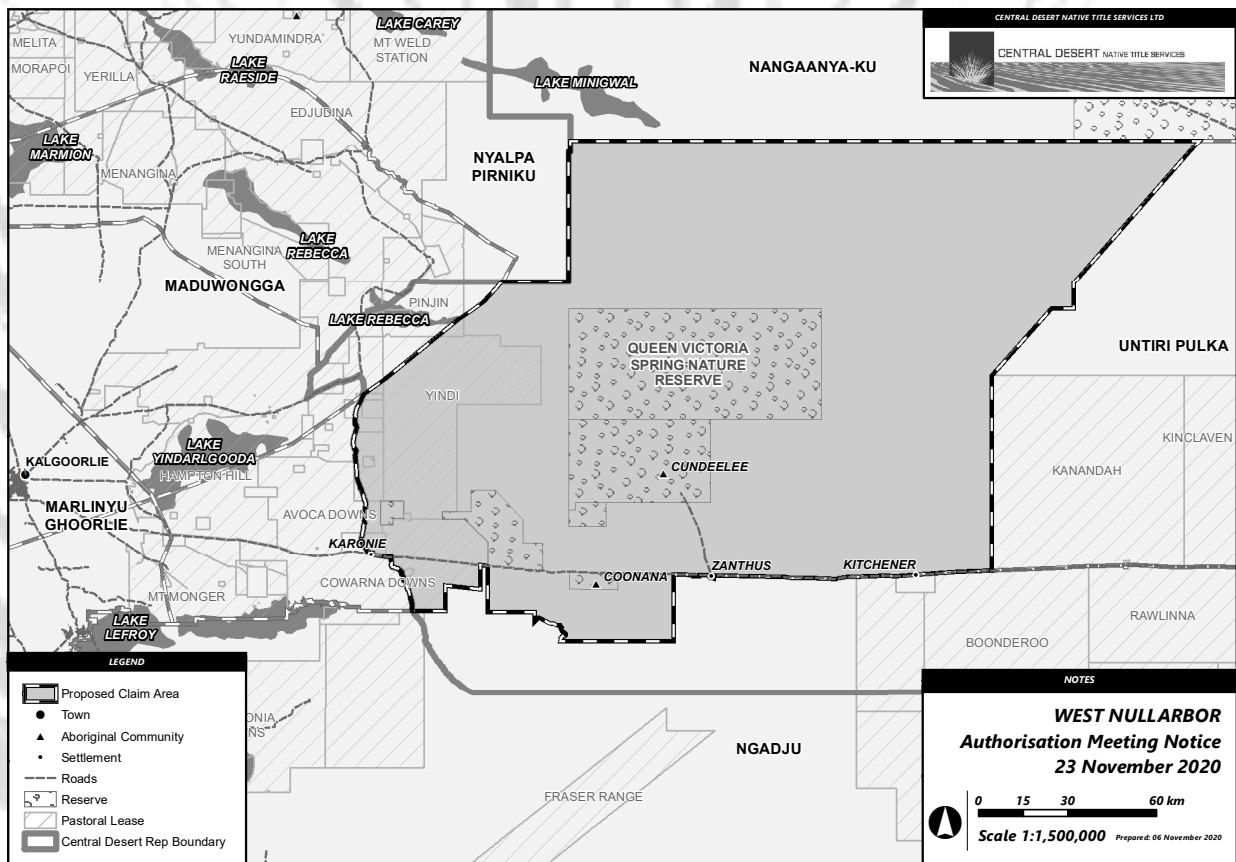

AGENDA

1. Background

- 1.1. Central Desert Native Title Services Ltd (**Central Desert**) has been researching in the “West Nullarbor” research area as shown on the attached map over recent years.
- 1.2. After extensive consultation and following the agreed outcome from the latest ‘community meeting’ held in Kalgoorlie on 12 October 2020, which discussed those people identified by Professor Scott Cane as having traditional connection to this area, a proposed new native title claim is ready to be ‘authorised’. This is a meeting that happens before a new native title claim can be filed in the Federal Court, where those people on the claim must meet and ‘authorise’ one or more people from that group to file the new claim on behalf of everyone. The meeting is called an ‘Authorisation Meeting’.
- 1.3. The proposed claim area to be discussed at the Authorisation Meeting starts at Karonie in the west and ends in the east at the Kanandah Station boundary. The proposed claim area includes;
 - a) Cundeelee Aboriginal Reserve;
 - b) Coonana Aboriginal Community;
 - c) Queen Victoria Springs,; and
 - d) the western side of the Indian Pacific Railway Line including Kitchener and Zanthus Stations,

2. Update on research and consultation with Native Title Services Goldfields

- 2.1. Central Desert advise that it has been unable to secure an ‘arrangement’ with Native Title Services Goldfields which Central Desert was requested to seek as an outcome from the last community meeting. This means that to be funded by Central Desert, the proposed boundary of the claim can only be within Central Desert’s representative region. The map of the proposed claim area reflects this.
- 2.2. At the ‘Authorisation Meeting’ Prof. Scott Cane will provide a summary of the research and consultations that have been done to prepare for the Authorisation Meeting and the filing of the proposed native title claim.

3. Things to be discussed and agreed at the Authorisation Meeting

- 3.1. **Claim Boundary** – the proposed new claim covers the area shown in the map attached to this notice.
- 3.2. **Claim Group Description** - this defines what people are included in the claim.
- 3.3. **Applicant** – the meeting will need to choose a person or people to be the ‘Applicant’. It is the Applicant’s job to bring the native title application on behalf of all the other people on the claim.

- 3.4. **Claim Name** – the people on the claim will need to choose a name for the claim, which will be how the claim is referred to by other people and by the courts.
