AGENDA:

1. Background – Getting back land over the Gibson Desert Nature Reserve

- The Gibson Desert mob are currently looking at two options for getting their land back over Gibson Desert Nature Reserve. Both options require the current law to be changed, by either the government in Perth or the government in Canberra.
- To be ready for a change to the law in Canberra, which most politicians in Canberra say should happen, Central Desert would like to help the Gibson Desert mob bring a new native title claim as soon as possible, 'just in case' that law changes sooner rather than later. This would allow the mob to be ready should that law change.
- Before a new native title claim can be filed, people on the claim must meet and 'authorise' one or more of that group to file the new claim on behalf of everybody. This is called an 'Authorisation Meeting.'
- When the new native title claim is authorised, it will not be progressed until the law in Canberra changes.

2. Update on research and consultation to date

- A lot of research was completed for the previous compensation claim and this information can be used to help bring a new native title claim.

3. Authorisation to bring the native title claim (if the law changes)

- Claim Boundary – the proposed claim is over **the area shown on the map attached to this notice.**
- Claim Group Description – this is how the people who will be included on the new claim will be described. See the next page for the proposed claim group description.
- Applicants – the meeting will need to choose some people to be the Applicant. It is the Applicant's job to bring the native title application on their behalf and on behalf of all of the other people on the new claim.
- Claim Name – the meeting will need to choose a name for the claim.

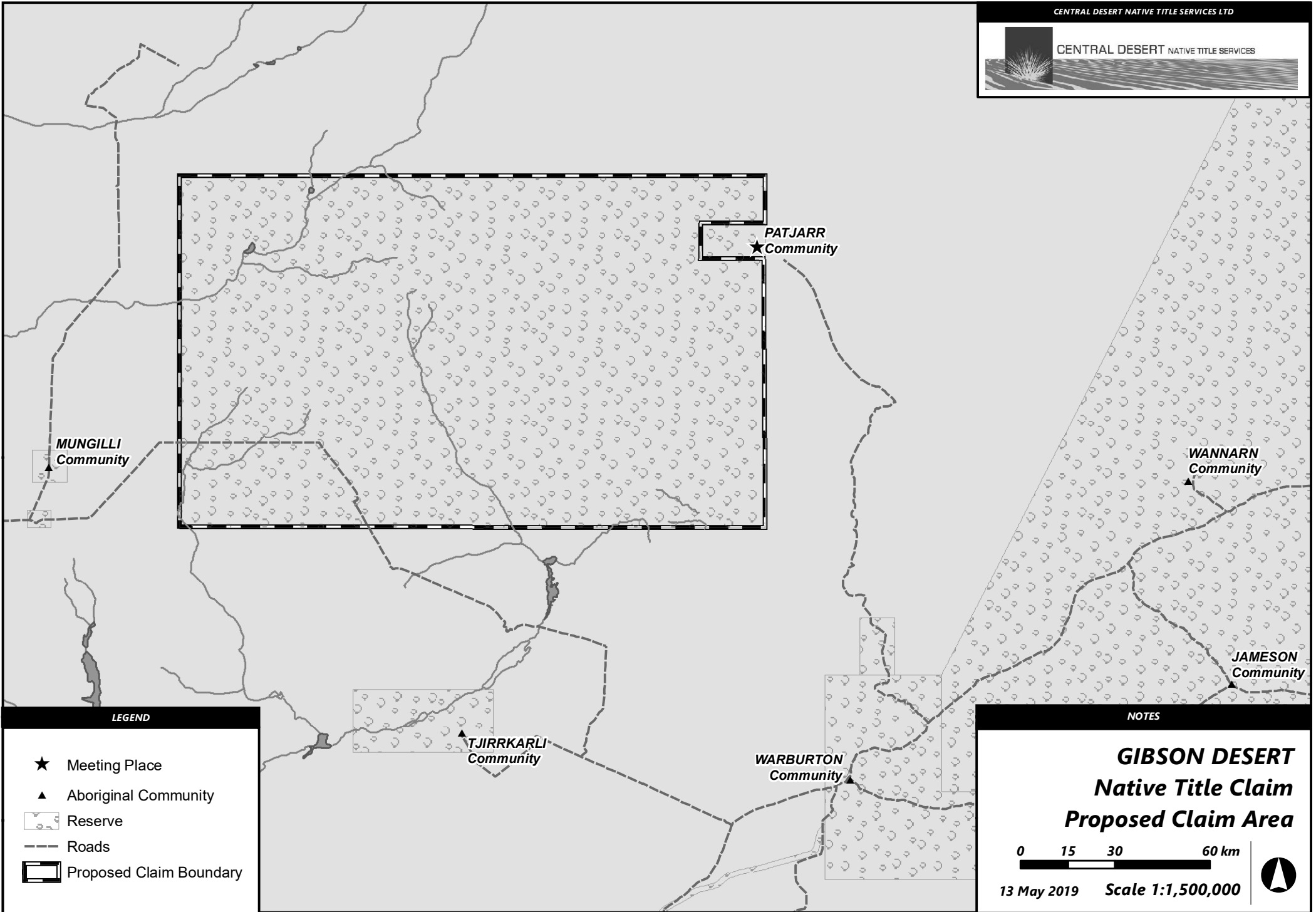

Attached: Map of Gibson Desert Nature Reserve claim area

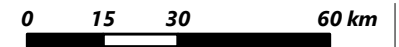
